Introduction

EDUCO ("<u>Company</u>" or "we") respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this privacy policy (this "Privacy Policy").

This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit <u>https://www.edu-co.fr</u> (this "Site") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing such information.

This Privacy Policy applies to information that we collect on this Site and in email, text and other electronic messages between you and this Site. It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other Site operated by the Company or any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries); or
- Any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries), including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or on this Site.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we treat it. By accessing or using this Site, you agree to this Privacy Policy. Therefore, if you do not agree with our policies and practices, you must not access or use this Site. This Privacy Policy may change from time to time as set forth more fully below. Your continued use of this Site after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check this Privacy Policy periodically for updates.

Children Under the Age of 18

This Site is not intended for children under 18 years of age. No one under the age 18 may provide any information to or on this Site. We do not knowingly collect information from children under 18. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of this Site, including information:

- By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address (including shipping and billing address), payment information (including credit card numbers), e-mail address, telephone number, or any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("Personal Information");
- That is about you but individually does not identify you, such as the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to this Site, cart information, and information about how you interact with this Site (collectively, with Personal Information, your "<u>Information</u>"); and/or
- About your internet connection, the equipment you use to access this Site, and usage details.

We collect this Information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through this Site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and Information collected through cookie, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our business partners and Google Analytics.

Information You Provide to Us

The Information we collect on or through this Site may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on this Site. This includes Information provided at the time of registering to use this Site, or requesting further services. We may also ask you for Information when you report a problem with this Site.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Details of transactions you carry out through this Site and of the fulfillment of your service orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through this Site.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with this Site, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain Information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

• Details of your visits to this Site, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on this Site.

• Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking).

The information we collect automatically may include Personal Information or we may maintain it or associate it with Personal Information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve this Site and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize this Site according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to this Site.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- **Cookies (or browser cookies)**. A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of this Site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to this Site.
- Web Beacons. Pages of this Site and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related Site statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain Site content and verifying system and server integrity).
- Flash Cookies. Certain features of this Site may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on this Site. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. How We Use Your Information

We use Information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any Personal Information:

- To protect and improve this Site;
- To present this Site and its contents to you;
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us;
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it;

- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection;
- To notify you about changes to this Site or any products or services we offer or provide though it;
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on this Site;
- To ensure you are in compliance with our General Terms and Conditions;
- To provide you with support and to respond to your inquiries, including to investigate and address your concerns and monitor and improve our responses;
- To send you occasional newsletters and updates;
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information; and
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We may also use your Information to contact you about our own and third-parties' goods and services that may be of interest to you. Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose Information that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:

- To our subsidiaries, parents and affiliates;
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business (including without limitation Google Analytics);
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Company's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Information held by the Company about this Site users is among the assets transferred;
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it;
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information; or
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your Information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request;
- To enforce or apply our <u>General Terms and Conditions</u> and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes;
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging Information

with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the Information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your Information:

- **Tracking Technologies and Advertising**. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this site may then be inaccessible or not function properly.
